- OSHA (Private employers): 5th Circuit C.O.A. ordered OSHA take no
 - action to enforce. OSHA suspended activities. Strike 1
- Federal Contractors: U.S. Dist. Ct. Judge temporarily halted Biden mandate for federal contractors across the country. Strike 2
- Challengers likely to prevail on claim that Biden exceeded his authority.
- Federal Employees lawsuits continue to play out.
